



Long-term Projections of Cancer Incidence and Mortality in Canada: The OncoSim All Cancers Model

STUDY PURPOSE





Using the OncoSim All Cancers
Model, this study estimates the
annual cancer incidence, mortality,
and cancer management costs in
Canada from 2020 to 2040



OncoSim is a free, web-based simulation tool that evaluates cancer control strategies

CONCLUSIONS & FUTURE IMPACT Breast, Lung

The four most commonly diagnosed cancers are projected to increase annually.

Overall number of cancer related **deaths** = projected to increase by 44% from 2020 to 2040.

Age standardized mortality rate is expected to remain **stable**.

More cancer related deaths projected in **males** than females.

Overall cancer management **costs** are projected to **increase** from 20.6B in 2020 to 31.4B in 2040.



This study highlights the importance of planning for increasing investment and capacity in cancer control.




