

Share your views on opioid prescriptions for cancer survivors



Opioids are frequently prescribed for cancer related pain. While opioids provide substantial benefit for pain management when use appropriately, they are also associated with serious risks.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

Individuals diagnosed with early-stage (I-III) head & neck, breast, lung, colorectal and prostate cancer with experience taking opioids or health care providers with experience prescribing opioids

WHAT IS INVOLVED?

You will be asked to participate in an interview (approximately 60 minutes) to share your thoughts and views on opioid prescriptions.

WHAT IS THE GOAL?

Your responses will be used to understand factors related to decision making around opioid prescribing. Using this information, we can help develop healthy policies including safe prescribing approaches for all cancer patients.
