

Sociodemographic and Psychosocial Patient and Physician Factors in Oncology Treatment Decision-Making

Researchers at the University of Calgary are recruiting **practicing medical oncologists in Alberta** for a study examining **how patient and physician sociodemographic and psychosocial factors influence chemotherapy decision-making**. The goal is to improve communication, reduce conflict, and support more effective shared decision-making in oncology care.

Methods

Participants will be asked to complete two brief **online questionnaires** (consisting of socio-demographic and psychosocial questions) and participate in a **one-on-one virtual (Zoom) interview** scheduled according to the oncologist's availability. Interviews are video-recorded and confidential and a \$25 gift card is provided.
